
Thomas was honest and straightforward

 "Let us also go, that we may die with Him." (John 11:16)




Every soul is precious

 (Isaiah 49:16)




When the Disciples failed, the Lord Christ stepped in




Requests are acceptable, but conditions are not

 "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe." (John 20:25)




He remained in the assembly of the Church
