

"For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death"



A death from which we ought to flee comes from...


3. A full grown sin:

A death which we ought to embrace comes from...


1. Being united with the Lord Christ in Baptism:

A death which we ought to embrace comes from...


3. Deeds of mortification:
