

Jesus comforting Martha, sister of Lazarus


"Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." (Jn. 11:21)

- Truth 1: There is no person above human pain or suffering




TRUTHS

Does God forget?




"Can a woman forget her nursing child, And not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, Yet I will not forget you." (Is. 49:15)
