Things to remember about the Plans of God




1. They unfold and develop to their perfection over time

- Either a warning message or that of hope; both are to move us to repentance.
- Between the asceticism of the Great Fast and the joy of the Holy Fifty Days
- St. Barnabas and St. Paul



3. All of God's plans are preceded by long preparations

- Between the promise of
 Salvation in the garden and His coming to the earth
- Between the Exodus from Egypt and entering the Promised Land
- St. John the Baptist and preparing the way for the Lord



4. The plans of God need the people of God to execute them

- Noah in his generation
- Moses and the deliverance of the people of Israel
- Jonah
- St. Mary
- St. Paul with his talents and zeal



5. We have to do our part in His Plans

- The tenth plaque
