- "...but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal." (Matt. 6:20)
- Paying Taxes to Caesar
- Rich Young Ruler
  - "Good Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?" (Matt. 19:16)



## An Unexpected Answer

- "What is written in the law? What is your reading of it?" (Lk. 10:26)
- The Lawyer wanted to justify himself
- The Good Samaritan
- Love is the summation of all God's commandments
  - "Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law." (Rom. 13:8)
  - For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another! (Gal. 5:12-13)
