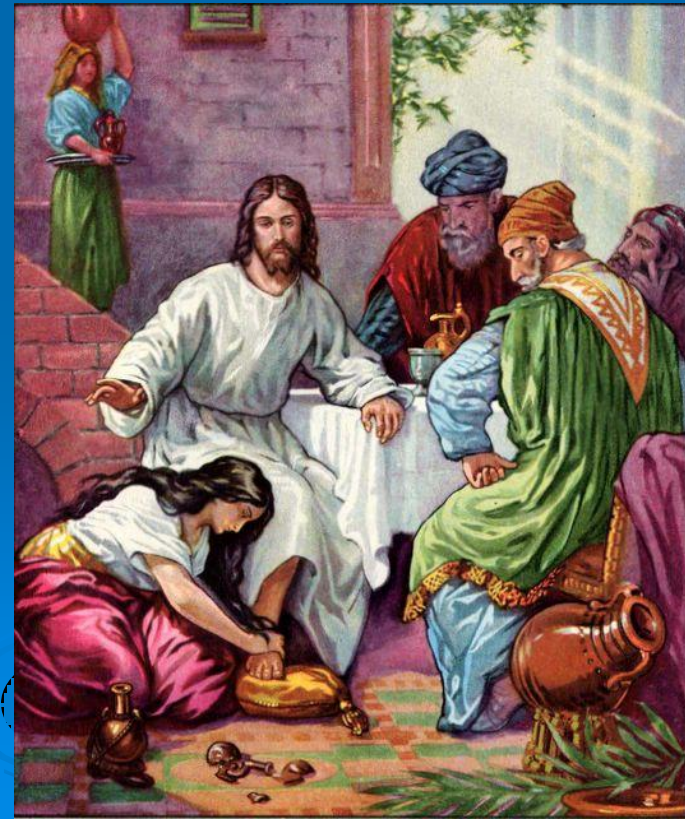

# □ How do I identify myself and others?

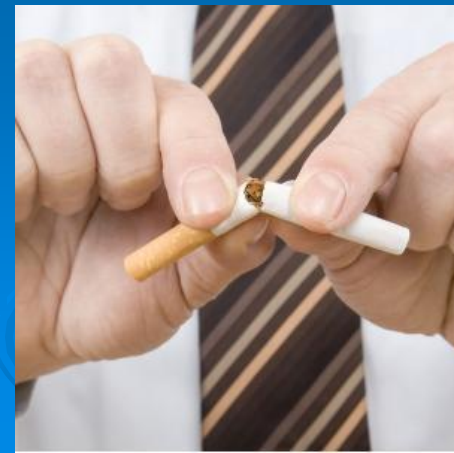
*“a woman in the city who was a sinner”*

- A sinful woman in the city or the “penitent woman”?



❑ Beware of those things that are easy to acquire and difficult to get rid of

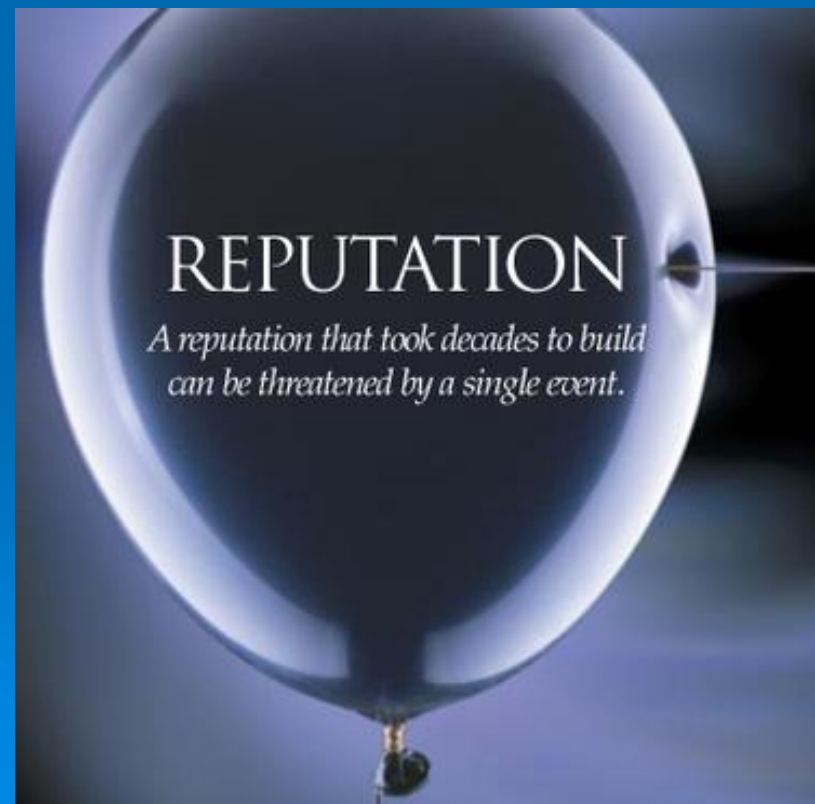
- Fighting against a mind stained with immorality and untamed body is the next battle for this woman

- Negative attitudes



□ ...and of those things that take years to build and minutes to destroy

*“a woman in the city who was a sinner”*

- Trust
- Unity
- Purity of heart and mind
