
"And behold, a woman in the city who was a sinner..."

☐ How do I identify myself and others? "a woman in the city who was a sinner"

- St. Peter: the one who denied Christ or the great apostle?
- St. Thomas: the doubter or the apostle and martyr?
- The prodigal son or the "younger brother"?
- A sinful woman in the city or the "penitent woman"?



☐ Beware of those things that are easy to acquire and difficult to get rid of

- Fighting against a mind stained with immorality and untamed body is the next battle for this woman
- Bad habits
- Negative attitudes






...and of those things that take years to build and minutes to destroy
