**1. Salt has no value of itself.
Its value comes from the
function it performs.**

**2. The salt has to dissolve
(disappear) to perform its
function.**

**3. The salt preserves the food
from decay; likewise, we are
in the world to preserve it
from corruption**

4. The salt is used as a sign of a covenant. We live this covenant in our relationship with God.

5. The salt is also a symbol of wisdom.
