



DISHONESTY: AMOS 8: 4-7

Hear this, you who swallow up the needy, And make the poor of the land fail, Saying: "When will the New Moon be past, That we may sell grain? And the Sabbath, That we may trade wheat?

Making the ephah small and the shekel large, Falsifying the scales by deceit,

REPRIMAND

- For dishonest gain:
- Making the ephah small and the shekel large,
 Falsifying the scales by deceit (NKJV)
- Skimping on the measure, boosting the price and cheating with dishonest scales (NIV)

EPHAH (MEASURE)

An ancient
 Hebrew dry
 measure
 equivalent to a
 bushel
 (~ 14 kg)





SHEKEL (MEASURE)

- A silver coin
- A Unit of weight used in ancient Israel





MAKING THE EPHAH SMALL AND THE SHEKEL LARGE

- The merchant will weight out an ephah of wheat
- He'll weight out a shekel of silver
- Making the ephah small and the shekel large is double-deceit!
 - He sells less grain and gets more silver


