Part 2 - My Role in Repentance

What is my role in repentance?

1. Acknowledge my sin

- “For I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is always before me.” (Ps. 50:3)
- Adam
- Cain
 - “I do not know. Am I my brother's keeper?” (Gen. 4:9)



What is my role in repentance?

1. Acknowledge my sin

- *“To see one’s sin is more profitable than seeing revelations.”* (St. Pachomius)
- We must measure ourselves with the Word of God
- “...my sin is always before me.”



What is my role in repentance?

2. My sin is against God

- “Against You, You only, have I sinned, And done this evil in Your sight...”
- Sin is against God
- EX: God spoke to Abimelech
 - “And God said to him in a dream, “Yes, I know that you did this in the integrity of your heart. For I also withheld you from sinning against Me; therefore I did not let you touch her.”
(Gen. 20:6)

What is my role in repentance?

3. Confess God's Justice

- “That You may be found just when You speak, And blameless when You judge.”
- When we justify God, we will be justified
- EX: Right hand thief
 - “...we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong.” (Lk. 23:41)
