


Preaching and Teaching I

 - Persuasion: Biblical, Logical
- + When to preach?
 - † All the time: in season and out of season

<u> Liturgy Sermons</u>

Related to the liturgy readings
Sunday readings are the same every year

- * "Therefore every scribe instructed concerning the kingdom of heaven is like a householder who brings out of his treasure things new and old." (Matt 13:52)
- † Can deliver "new" out of "old":
 - Samaritan Woman: Repentance, Worship, Faithfulness, Honesty, Service, ...

* Liturgy, Sunday School: limited time

† Not too long, not too short

† Special liturgies: late liturgies (great fast), early liturgies (workers), special occasions (last Friday of Great Fast)


† Read the audience

† tired, anxious, bored, attentive, ...





Deep Topics in General Sermons
 Can introduce a simple small aspect as a "side note"
 Words of the Lord on the Cross
 "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise." (Lk 23:43)
 His Spirit will not linger for 3 days (proof of resurrection)
 Paradise, not Kingdom... differentiate



* Children – stories, animals, crafts


* Teenagers – topics to answer their many questions and confusions


* Youth – applicable topics
