WALKING *in Holiness*

I. IT IS EVERYONE'S CALLING

- “because it is written, “Be holy, for I am holy.” *1 Peter 1: 16*
- “... To all who are in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints” *Romans 1: 7*
- “For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness”
1 Thessalonians 4: 7
- The white garment for the baptized.



II. IT IS A REQUIRED CONDITION

- “Pursue peace with all *people*, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord”

Hebrews 12: 14



III. IT IS A STRUGGLE

- “And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure”
1 John 3: 3
- “...that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, not in passion of lust, like the Gentiles who do not know God” *1 Thessalonians 4: 4 -5*



IV. IT IS A GRACE

- The pursuit of holiness is supported by the work of the sacrifice.
