

I. THE CORRUPT WILL (1)


- "For this they willfully forget"2 Peter 3: 5
- The atheists' denial of God's existence and their will to live with no accountability to His authority.



I. THE CORRUPT WILL (2)

The peoples' request for a council from Jeremiah and God's response "For you were hypocrites in your hearts when you sent me to the LORD your God, saying, 'Pray for us to the LORD our God, and according to all that the LORD your God says, so declare to us and we will do it.' And I have this day declared it to you, but you have not obeyed the voice of the LORD your God"

Jeremiah 42: 21 - 22



II. DESPISING GOD'S SIMPLICITY (1)

John 6: 52


• The stumbling at the Sacraments and the power that God put in them.



II. DESPISING GOD'S SIMPLICITY (2)

1 Cor. 1: 23




III. WISE IN THEIR OWN EYES (1)

III. WISE IN THEIR OWN EYES (2)



IV. THE ABANDONMENT OF GRACE



■ Jonah's flee from God's assignment at the beginning "Ah, LORD, was not this what I said when I was still in my country? Therefore, I fled previously to Tarshish; for I know that You are a gracious and merciful God, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness, One who relents from doing harm" Jonah 4: 2
