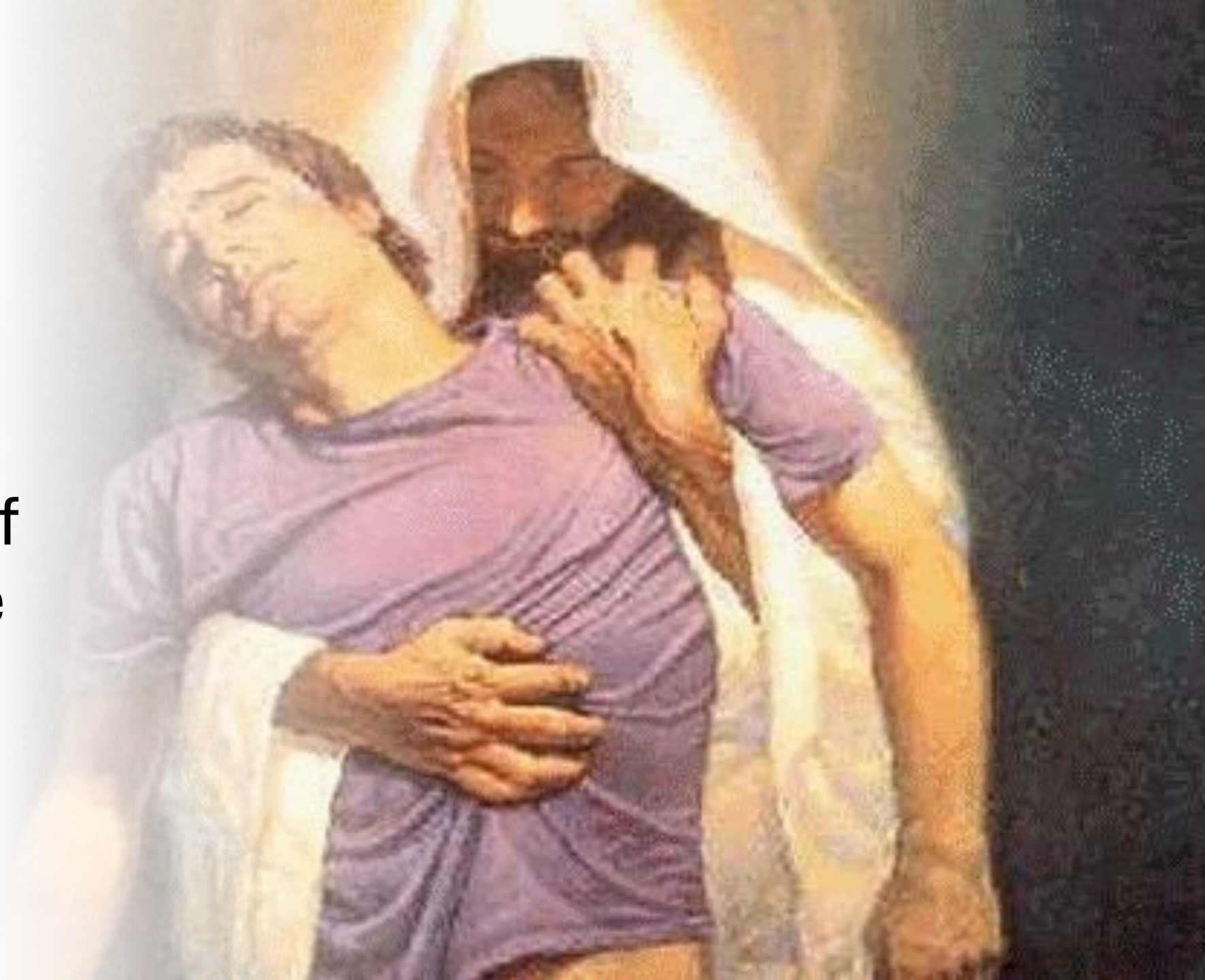

1. Understanding:

- ✓ The sin of Abraham lying about his wife; Sarah.
- ✓ The sin of Jacob tricking his father Isaac to receive his blessing.

2. Patience:

- ✓ Jonah the Prophet “Then the LORD said, “Is it right for you to be angry?” *Jonah 4:4*
- ✓ The older brother in the parable of the prodigal son.

3. To be defended:

- ✓ The woman caught in adultery in John 8.
- ✓ Defending the woman who washed the Lord's feet at the house of Simeon the pharisee in Luke 7

4. Respect:

- ✓ The Samaritan woman

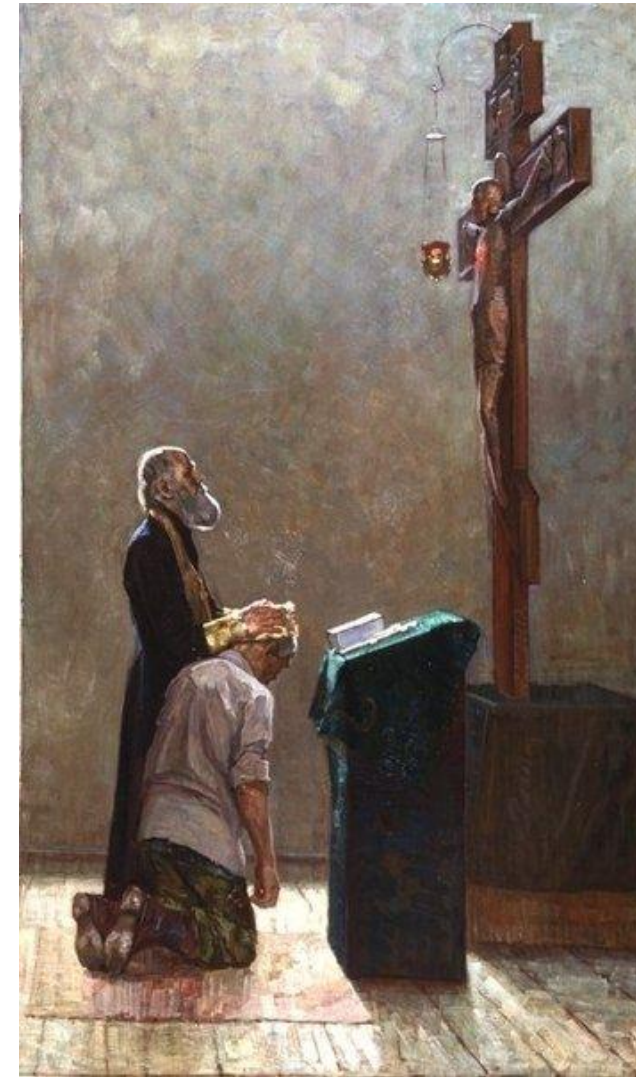

5. Assurance of acceptance:
- ✓ “...the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out” John 6:37
  - ✓ “And when they had nothing with which to repay, he freely forgave them both” *Luke 7:42*
  - ✓ “I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven” *Matthew 18:22*

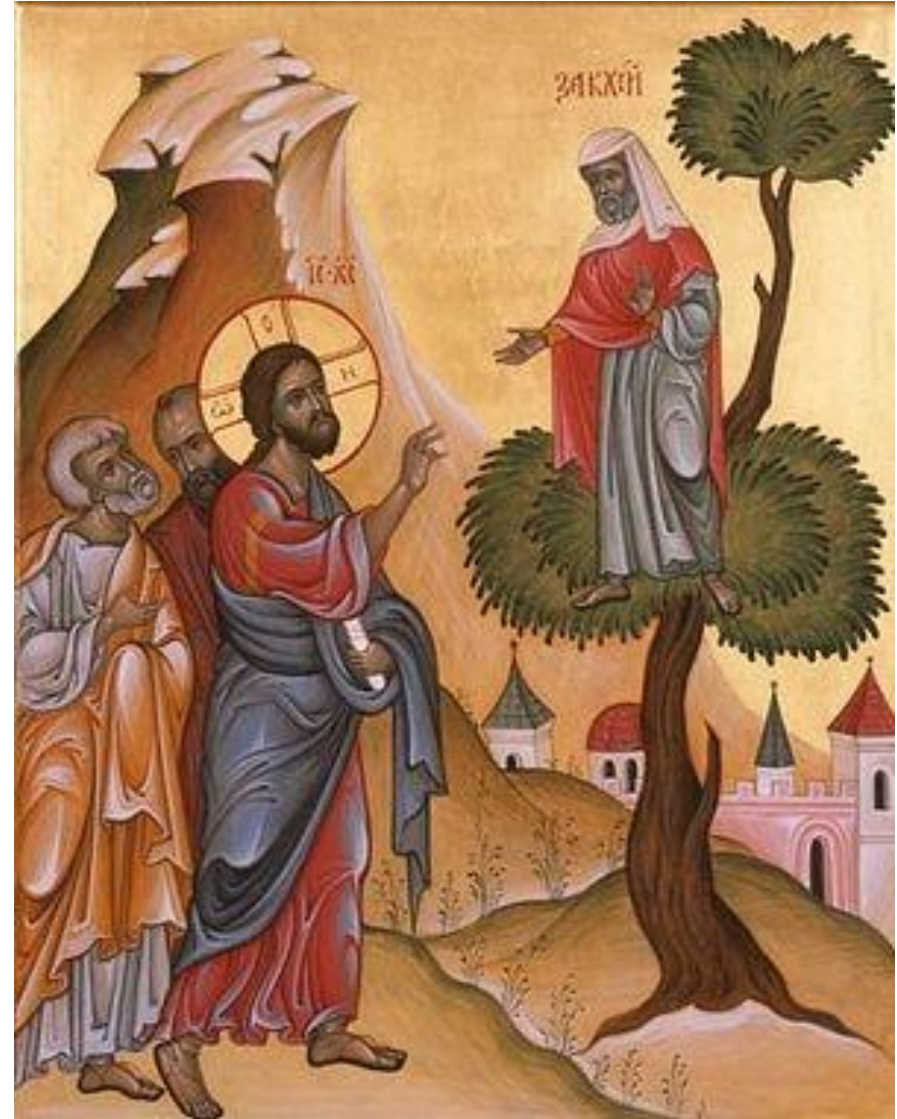


6. Hearing a word of forgiveness:

- ✓ “When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son, your sins are forgiven you.” *Mark 2:5*
- ✓ The Sacrament of confession and hearing the absolution.

7. To be seen as valuable:
- ✓ Calling Levi, (St. Matthew) the tax collector, to be a disciple.
  - ✓ Blessing Zacchaeus house with a visit
8. A second chance:
- ✓ The Prodigal son
  - ✓ St. Peter

9. Deleting the records:

- ✓ “You will cast all our sins Into the depths of the sea” *Micah 7:19*

10. Compassion and restoration of dignity:

- ✓ The Lord Jesus healing the leper  
“Then Jesus put out *His* hand and touched him, saying, “I am willing; be cleansed.” Immediately his leprosy was cleansed” *Matthew 8:3*

11. Cleansing and purification:

- ✓ “Though your sins are like scarlet,  
They shall be as white as snow” *Isaiah 1:18*
- ✓ “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and  
just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse  
us from all unrighteousness” *1 John 1:9*
- ✓ The Eucharist.

12. Hope:

- ✓ “He shall bruise your head”

*Genesis 3:15*

- ✓ “For a righteous *man* may fall seven times And rise again” *Proverbs 24:16*

- ✓ Talking with Cain: “If you do well, will you not be accepted?” *Genesis 4:7*
