1. LOVE

 - + Do I consider it a sin to stop praying?
 - * "Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the Lord in ceasing to pray for you" (1sam 12:23)

3. GIVING AND SACRIFICE

- × A servant gives without obligation.
- Gives to everyone in every occasion, everywhere.
- Do I have the ability to sacrifice my fun time to visit the kids?
- What is the feeling I get when I do those things?
 - + Giving? Or taking?

- * St. Paul was concerned with his.
 - + "But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified" (1 Cor 9:27)

6. ZEAL

- Can I say with St. Paul
 - + "Who is weak, and I am not weak? Who is made to stumble, and I do not burn with indignation" (2 Cor 11:29)
- Do I search for the lost sheep?
- × St. Paul also said
 - + "I have become all things to all men, that I might by all means save some" (1 Cor 9:22)
