DISCIPLINE

1. By sending them two by two,
there was an implied lesson that
they ought to work together

2. The harvest is always greater than the laborers: Ask the Lord of the harvest

- It is not your harvest
- You are not working alone

3. Never forget or lose your identity:
You are “lambs among wolves”

4. You are not your own providers

“Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals”

5. Stay focused: The discipline in handling relationships

“...and greet no one along the road”
Luke 10:4

6. Speak peace with everyone, even if not welcomed

“But whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’ And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you.”

7. Rejoice for the right reason:
“your names are written in heaven”
